

Book Club Questions for SADIE.

Story:

1. What is the significance of the title, SADIE? Would you have picked a different title? If yes, what would it be?
2. What were the major themes in SADIE?
3. What scene was the most pivotal?
4. How do you think Sadie's story would have changed had that scene not taken place?
5. Have you ever had a friend betray your trust like Guillermo betrayed Sadie? How did you react to it differently than Sadie? How did you react the same?
6. What surprised you the most about Sadie's choices?
7. Were there any particular quotes that stood out to you? Why?

Characters:

8. Did any of the characters remind you of yourself or someone you know? How?
9. What was motivating the actions of Sadie in the story? What was motivating Guillermo? Josh? What did the other characters want from Sadie and what did Sadie want with them?
10. What were the dynamics of "power" between Sadie and Guillermo? How did that factor in plot? How did that influence Sadie's interactions with others?
11. How does the way Sadie see herself differ when she is around Guillermo or the four boys? How did that affect who she chose in the end?
12. If you could smack any of the characters upside the head, who would it be and why?
13. Were there any moments where you disagreed with the choices of Sadie? How about Josh? What would you have done differently?
14. What past influences were shaping the actions of Sadie, Josh, or Guillermo?

The Ending:

15. Did you think the ending was appropriate? How would you have liked to have seen the ending go differently?
16. How had Sadie changed by the end of the book? How had Josh changed? Had Guillermo changed as a result of Sadie's choices?
17. Have any of YOUR views or thoughts changed after reading this book?
18. What do you think will happen next to Sadie and Josh? To Guillermo?
